How to make your quizzer

- Carefully cut out** the quizzer with the help of an adult.
- Fold the page** in half on the side with all the questions and pictures. Unfold it and fold in the other direction so you have a cross on your quizzer.
- Turn the quizzer over** and fold the corners into the middle so it looks like this: 
- Turn the quizzer over again** and fold the corners into the middle again. So it's even smaller!
- Fold in half** and open up and fold in half again.
- Put your fingers** into the corners to make your DKfindout! True or False Animal Quizzer work.

How to play

- Ask a friend** to pick one of the animal pictures from the outside. Then open and close the quizzer the number of letters in the animals name eg. "tiger" would be 5 opens and closes.
- Get your friend** to pick one of the topics from the inside. And again open and close the quizzer the right number of times.
- This time they** must pick the topic they are going to answer a true or false question on.
- It's your choice** what they win if they get it right and what happens if they lose!
